- ❖ Bow and mooring numbers are registered with the state. If you wish to share a mooring you must file the proper paperwork with the mooring manager first.

- ❖ If you park your empty boat trailer in the back parking lot, be sure to park in the area for empty trailers.
  
- ❖ If you are a mooring owner for this season and you wish to share a mooring with family or friends, you must first file all paper work (registration and liability policy) with the mooring manager. Your bow numbers are recorded with the marine patrol, and they do monitor this.
  
- ❖ Headway speed only when within 150 feet of docks, swim line, and mooring field. Marine patrol monitors our water front for this violation.
